splitmail - split mailbox files prior to indexing

SYNOPSIS

```
splitmail -p prefix [ file ]
```

DESCRIPTION

splitmail is a utility to split a mailbox file (or standard input) comprised of multiple messages into multiple files of individual messages to facilitate indexing with **index**(1). The generated files have 5-digit increasing numbers appended to a common prefix.

OPTIONS

-**p** prefix Specifies the common prefix.

EXAMPLE

The command:

```
splitmail -p msg sent_messages
```

splits the mailbox sent_messages into files named msg.00001, msg.00002, and so on.

NOTE

This utility hasn't been exhaustively tested.
